EFN & GAMIAN Joint Statement on supporting Frontline Nurses Mental Health & Wellbeing - COVID-19 Preparedness



Since the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic, all those on the frontline against the virus had to face situations of unprecedented hardship while caring for their communities.

The EFN reflected on the [lessons learned](#) from COVID-19 building on what nurses experienced in 2014 with Ebola and in 2020 with COVID19.

Based on this EFN Report, specifically related to the Recommendation on Mental Health and Wellbeing, **EFN and GAMIAN** have developed a [Joint Statement](#) to convince the European Commission, the European Parliament and the Council of Ministers to “take care of those who care”.

Let’s get better prepared as this COVID-19 disruption is not yet over! We are only prepared, unless we are all prepared. That is the lesson learned out of the Ebola and Covid-19 pandemic.
